- gasoline and kerosene
- household cleaners  
ammonia, drain openers,  
acid cleaners, oven cleaners
- mercury
- paint products  
latex, oil based, alkyd based,  
arts/crafts chemicals,  
rust preservatives, creosote,  
water sealers, paint thinners,  
furniture strippers
- pesticides/herbicides  
rodent killers, insecticides,  
weed killers, mothballs, fertilizer
