

# Household Recycling Guidelines

Spring 2020

The following materials are accepted by nearly all curbside collection programs in SW PA.

Always check your local guidelines as rules vary by location.



**Plastic Bottles, Jars & Jugs**—includes all containers with a screw top lid and a neck narrower than the body. Caps are OK if they are attached to the container.



**Steel & Aluminum Cans**—Labels are OK. Please remove all food and lightly rinse. Place steel can lids into can and squeeze can closed.



**Cardboard Boxes**—flatten all boxes. Labels and tape are ok. Includes cereal boxes, brown paper bags and similar.



**Mixed Paper**— Includes magazines, junkmail, newspapers and office papers.

The following materials are **NOT** accepted by most curbside collection programs in SW PA.

Always check your local guidelines as rules vary by location.



**Coffee Pods** and any materials less than 2 inches in any dimension



**Styrofoam Cups and Containers** and any plastics marked #3, #4, #6 or #7



**Plastic Bags** and any other plastic films, pouches or wraps



**Paper Cartons, aseptic** and juice boxes or pouches



**Plastic Clamshells and Boxes**



**Glass Bottles and Jars**



**Plastic straws** and coffee stirrers



**Plastic and Paper Cups**
